Friday, January 15: Trekking in Peru

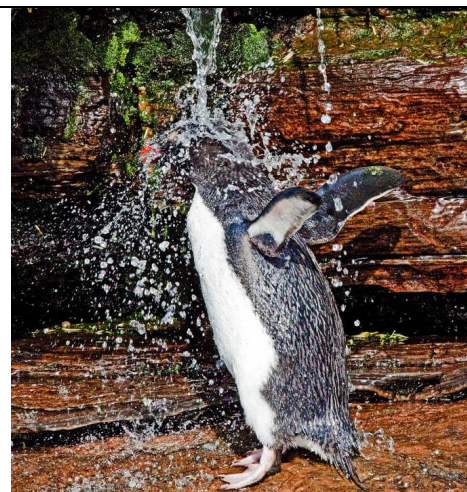
